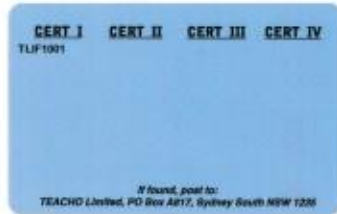


BLUECARD

YOUR TRANSPORT INDUSTRY PASSPORT

BLUECARD started from the need within the transport industry to have some entry level WH&S training standard across the industry. The program aims to reduce the number of incidents within the industry and also satisfies WorkCover requirements for WH&S induction training.

This program is endorsed by TEACHO LTD – Transport Education Audit Compliance Health Organisation and is designed for any transport and logistics worker in NSW. Successful completion of the BlueCard program can also lead to career development opportunities if participants chose to continue on and complete the full TLI qualification.



The BlueCard will identify the Registered Training Organisation (RTO) that you undertook the training with and records of future training qualification can be added on back of the card.

WHAT IS THE BLUECARD?

The BLUECARD is a minimum entry level WH&S unit of competency for the transport & logistics industry. The BLUECARD is a safety awareness program that is aligned to the National Competency Standard;

TLIF1001 – “Follow Work, Health & Safety Procedures”.

This competency is one of a number of competencies required to obtain a Certificate III in Warehousing Operations or a Certificate III in Driving Operations.

PURPOSE OF BLUECARD TRAINING

- Understand WH&S Act requirements
- Identifies you can comply with Policies
- Work Safely
- Recognises you can follow and apply WH&S Procedures

BENEFITS

- Acknowledgement you have achieved a National Unit of Competence (UOC)
- This UOC can lead into a National recognised full Qualification
- Transport and Logistics companies will look on you favourably
- Assist you with casual or fulltime employment

HALF DAY PROGRAM

(Recognition of Current Competencies) \$242 + GST where applicable - Minimum class of 8

Participants complete a 4 hour workshop with a qualified Trainer/Assessor.

This pathway is for employees and prospective employees within the Transport and Logistics industry.

Upon successful completion of the requirements, participants will be issued with a nationally recognised Statement of Attainment certifying that

The participant has demonstrated competence to the National Standards in the unit TLIF1001 from the TLI training package - Transport and Logistics.

The BlueCard itself can take up to four weeks to arrive after you have been deemed competent. ATS will post BlueCard to you along with the original Statement of Attainment. A copy of the Statement of Attainment will be issued initially so you have proof of competency.
